What does United Community do?

Enables partners to send and receive electronic referrals, address people's social needs, and improve health, education, and financial wellbeing across communities.

What services does United Community provide?

Partners can make electronic referrals, securely share client information, track outcomes, and inform community-wide outcomes.

Who does United Community serve?

United Community serves partners in Jefferson, Oldham, Shelby, Bullitt counties in Kentucky and Clark, Floyd, and Harrison in Indiana.

What technology does United Community use?
