Eviction Record Expungement

Seals dismissed cases and protects minors from eviction records. Preserves landlord rights while preventing family hardships from becoming lifelong barriers.

Yes In God's Back Yard (YIGBY)

Allows faith communities to build housing by right on owned property. Unlocks thousands of acres and reduces red tape for housing production.

Tenant Medical Relief Act

Provides compassionate lease termination during medical crises—extended care, caregiving, spouse loss, or lead exposure. Protects tenants while offering Landlords predictable procedures.

BUDGET SOLUTIONS

Strengthen Housing Trust Fund

Modernize deed transfer fees and tie to inflation to increase dedicated funding to the statewide fund. Supports affordable homeownership and rentals statewide.

State Housing Tax Credit

Match neighboring states (OH, IN, IL, MO, TN, VA) to leverage private investment and produce workforce housing.

Revolving Loan Fund

Flexible financing for public-private partnerships. Accelerates multi-type, multi-income housing production.
